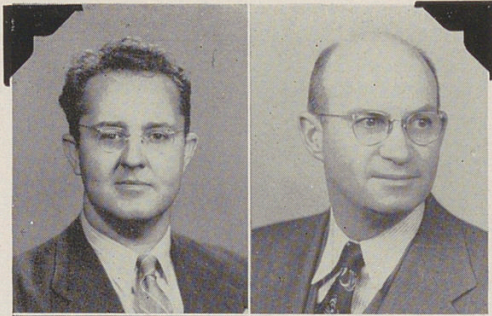
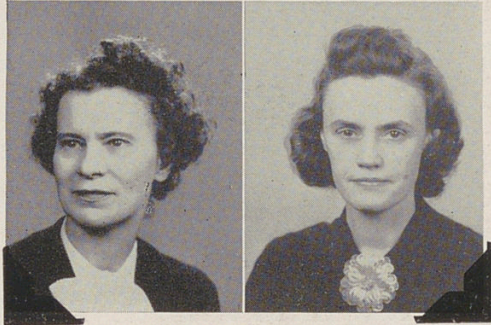


FACULTY
