"A jolly girl who can keep a conversation lively. You can always see her wearing a smile. She loves to sing!"

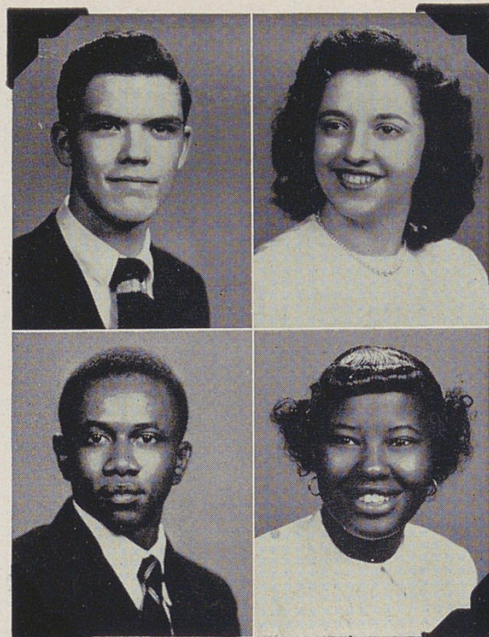
BENNETT, JOHN
