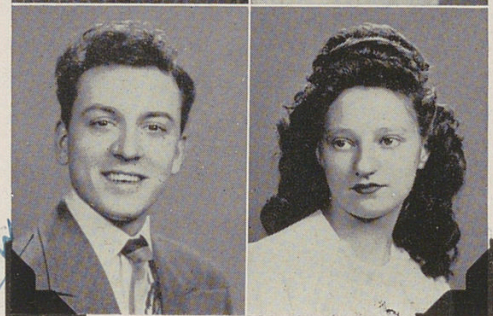


BOURNE, HERSCHEL M.

BRYANT, JEANETTE

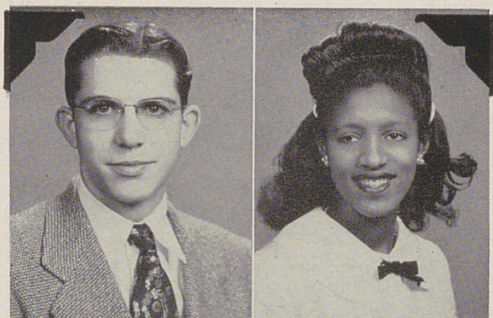
Y-Teens.

"A sweet little girl, and very friendly. Always smiling. Nice to know, and fun to have around."



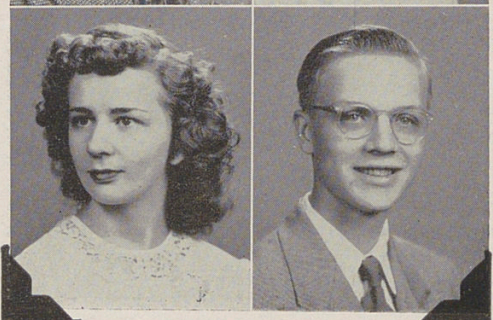
BUGGE, THOMAS
