BURNETT, ERMA LEE

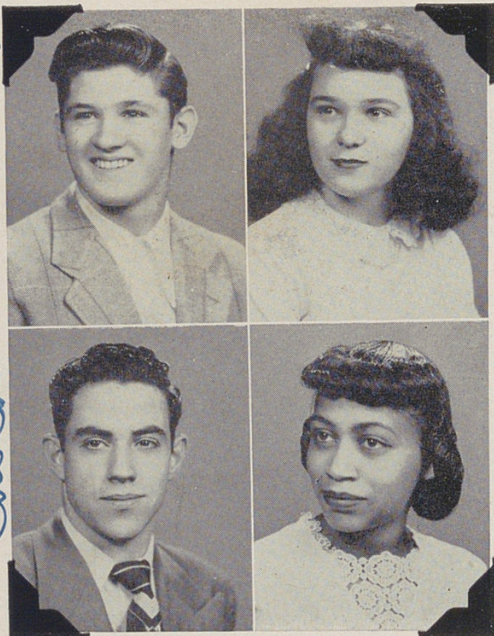
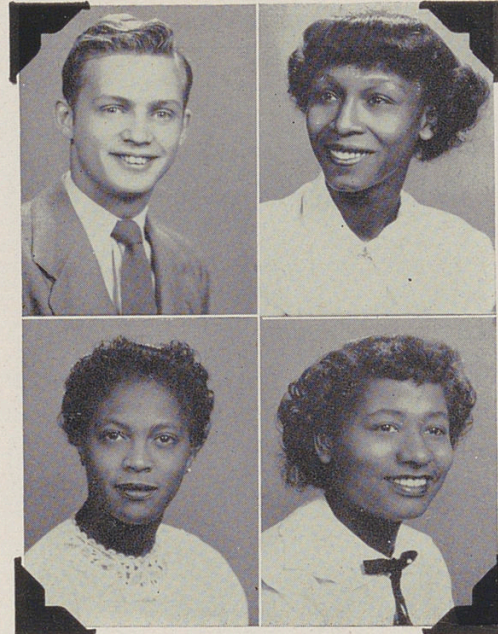
G. A. A., Choir.

CARRIER, BOB G.

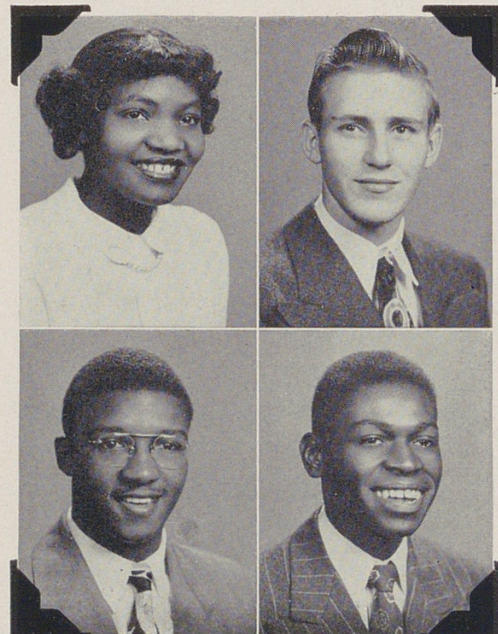
"A quiet fellow but most likeable. Has a fine circle of friends who appreciate his soft spoken manner."
