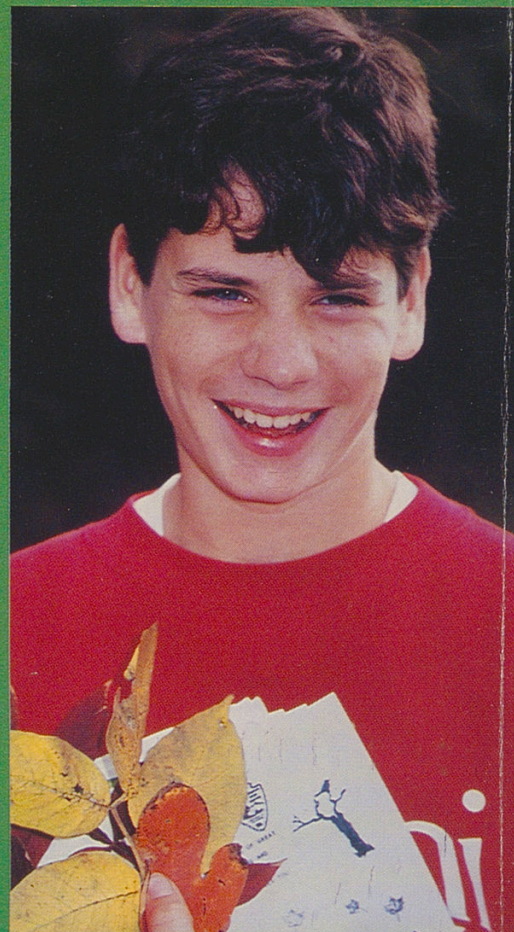
The boys basketball program started its own tradition with a new coach and a new motto — "The Tradition Begins Now." Students began to STAND through basket-

ball games, cheering their fellow classmates on whether they won or lost.

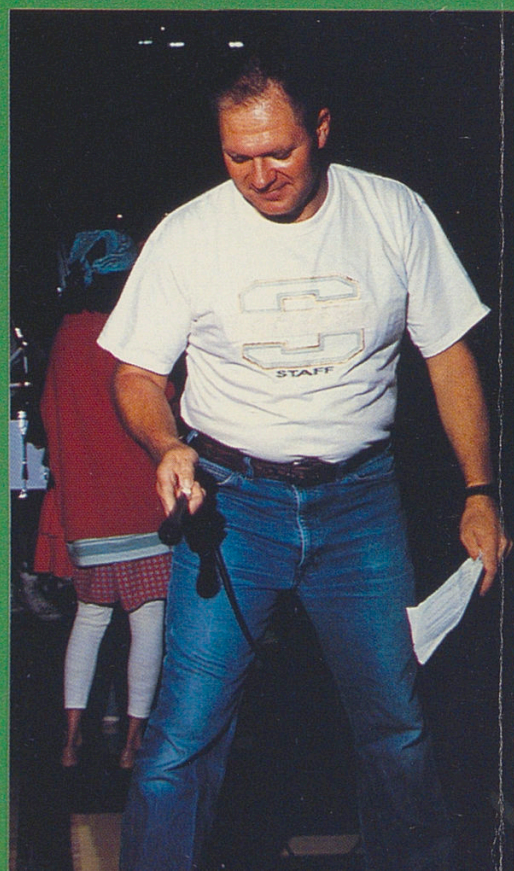

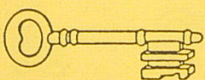
