## Students Earn Recognition

**F**riday, May 31 marked Sycamore High School's annual Underclass Awards ceremony. Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors were rewarded for their achievements in the various areas of art, foreign language, math, social sciences, sciences, English, photography, marketing, and vocational studies.
