

Sports and Pep Rallies

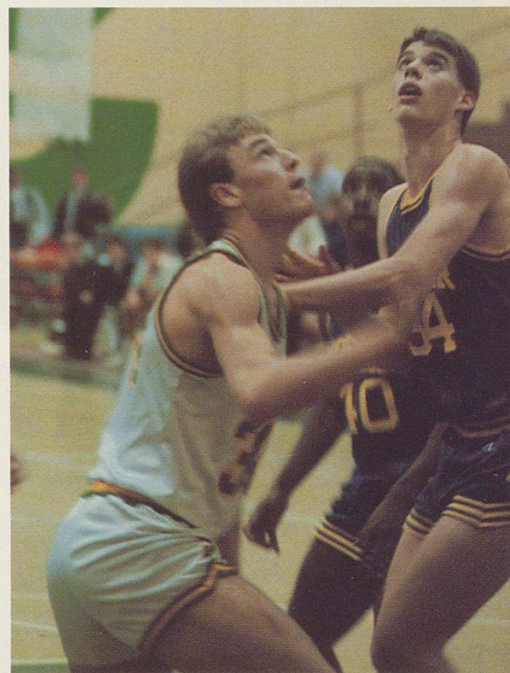
