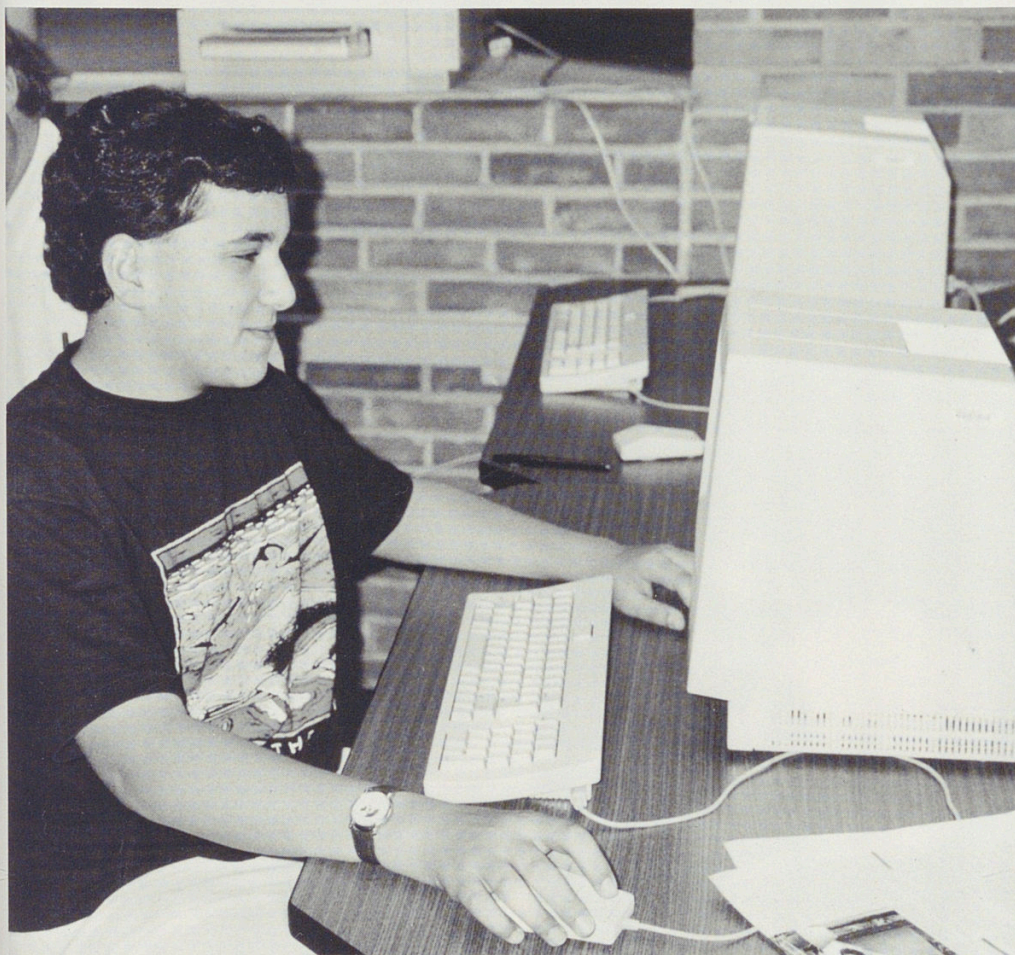
The 1992 Log was designed by the yearbook staff of Sycamore High School in Cincinnati, Ohio. The goal was to create an accurate historical document reflecting the unique people, places, and events of Sycamore High School in 1991-1992.

There were 1000 copies printed in the 9" by 12" size with 224 pages. Our publisher was Josten's Printing and Publishing and our plant was the Winston-Salem, NC facility. The book is printed on 80 pound gloss paper with black ink. Our spot color ink is green Tempo color 349. Our text is Times typestyle with 9 point captions and 10 point body copy. Headline styles are Times, Present, and Trajan.

Folio tabs are 7 point Times and include original student leaf art.

The four-color process section of the book includes the use of Tempo color 349 as an added highlight.

The cover is a student designed embossed leatherex material. Pearl is the base material and gold foil and green Tempo color 345 has been silkscreened. The grain is Mission number 1212. Tempo color 345 has also been used on the spine.
