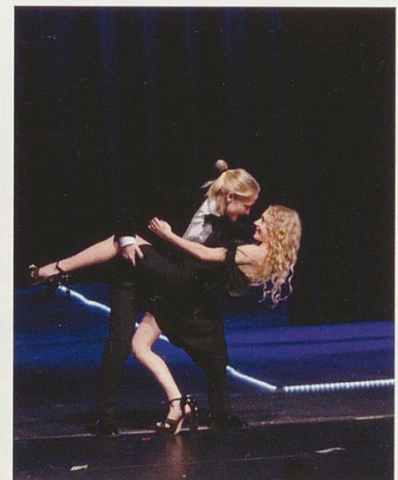
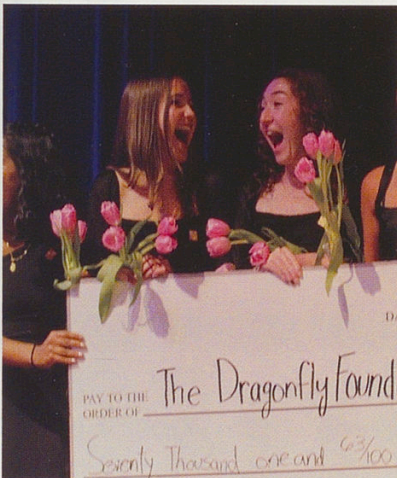




fashion for the **cure**
