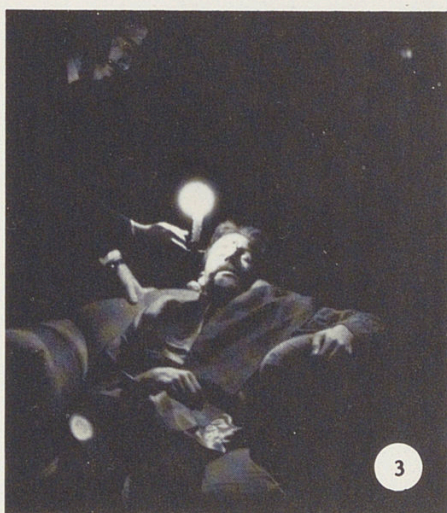
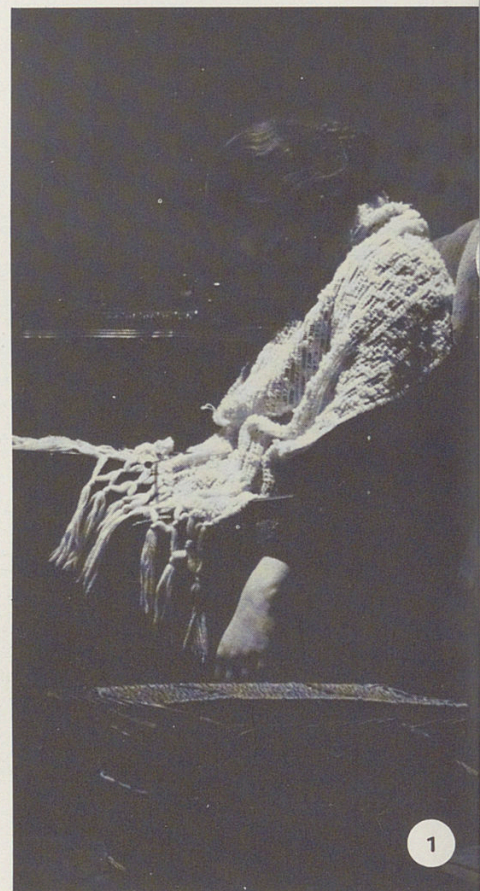
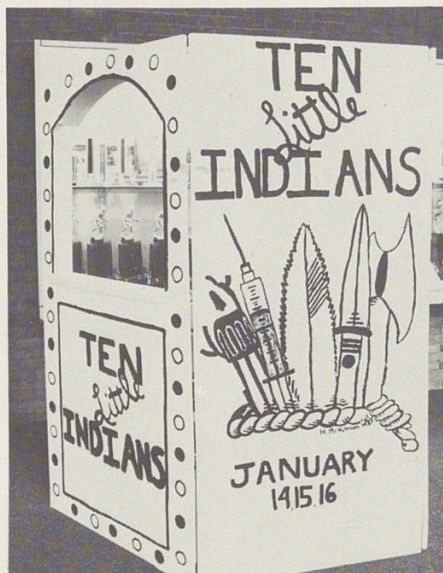


Ten Little Indians
