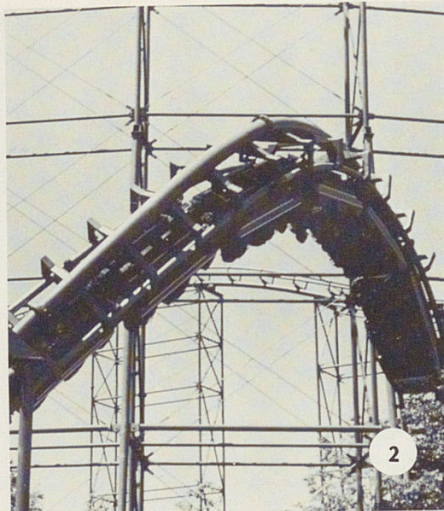
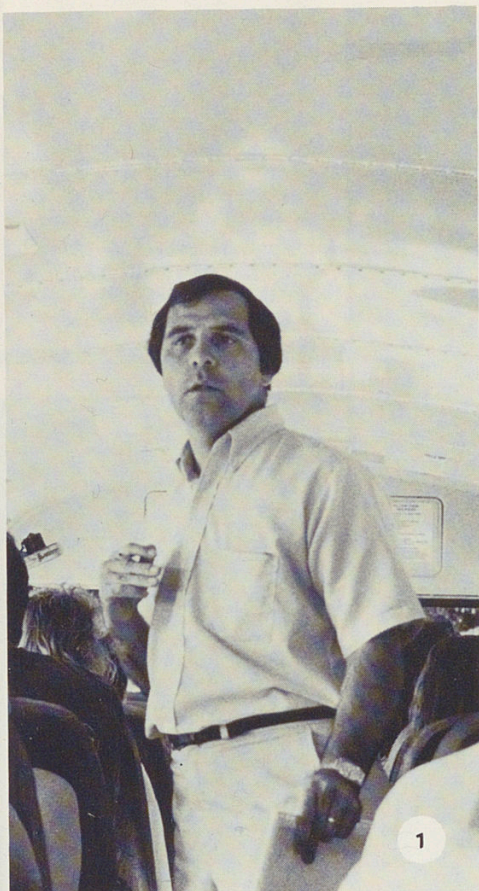


Physics Fun
