



Boys' Swimming

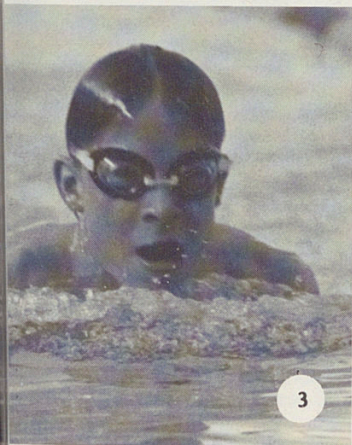
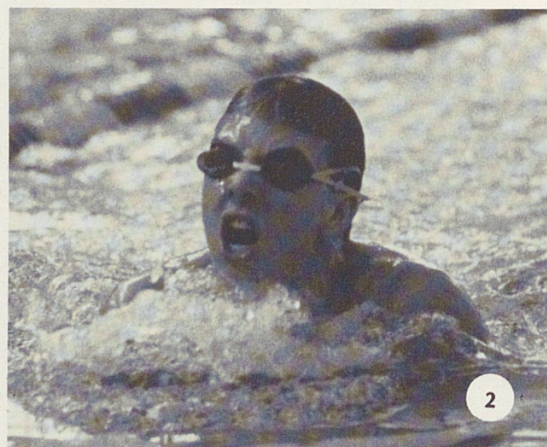
