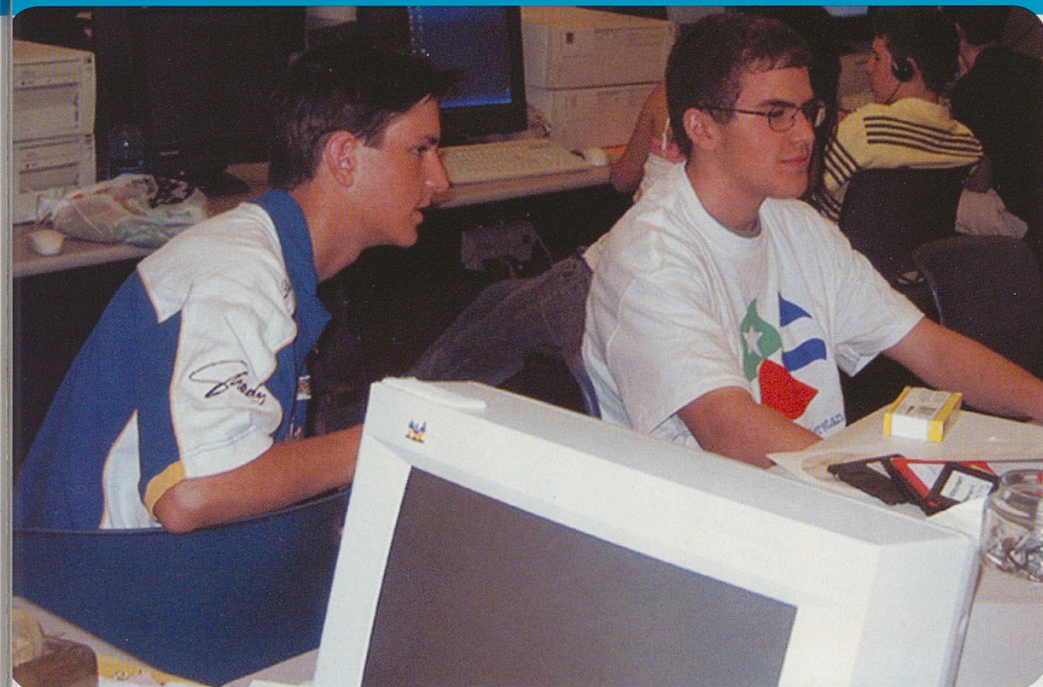




**Time to type!** Sheila Campbell, 11, was practicing and improving her skills in her computer class on a daily basis. When class time began, she got straight off to work.

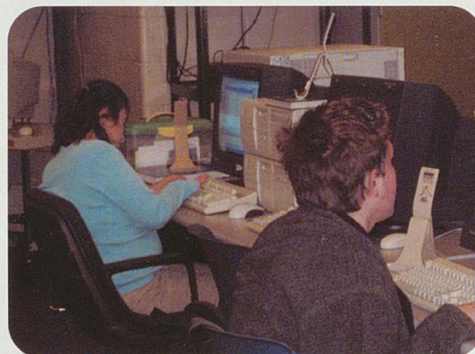
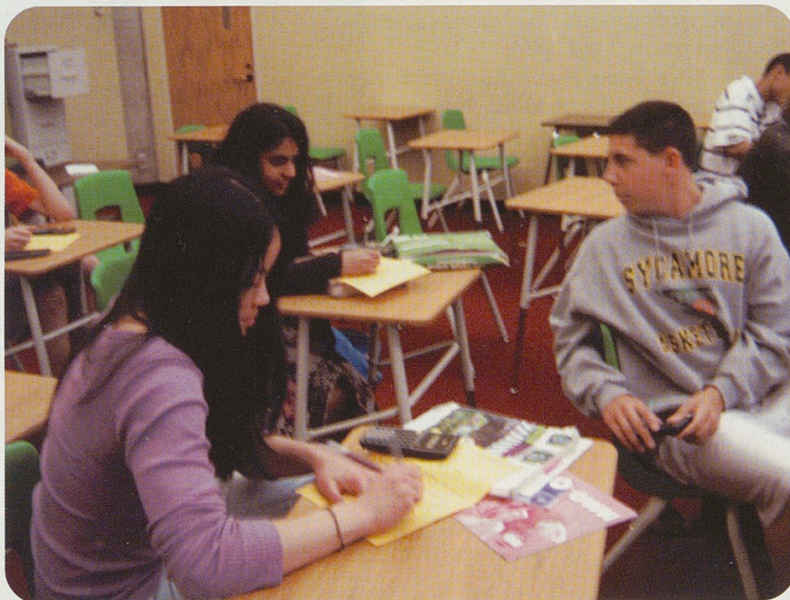


**End of classtime.** Stephen Stein, 9, is getting ready to leave class after a busy day. Being one of the last ones to leave really showed his commitment to the class.
