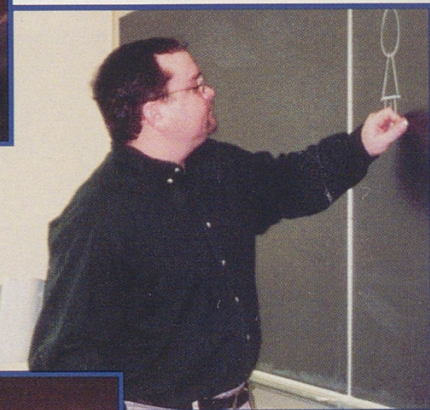


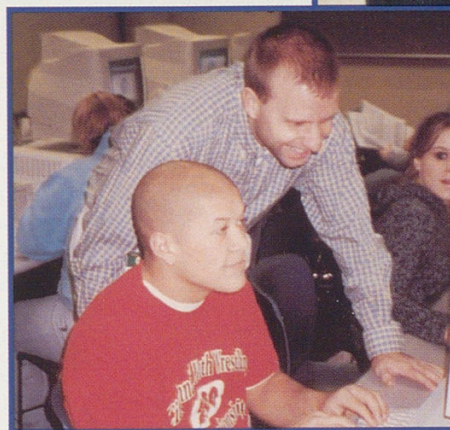
**To the Senior Class:

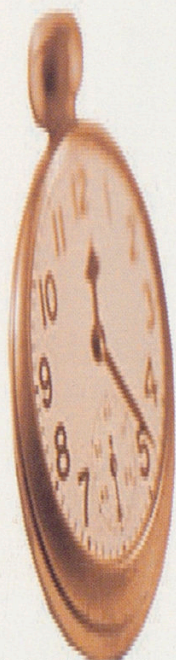
