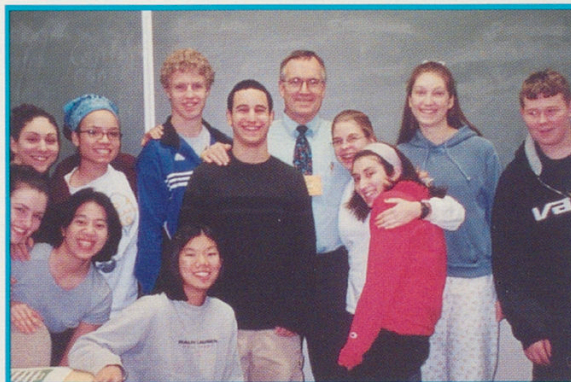


Leaving Us Behind

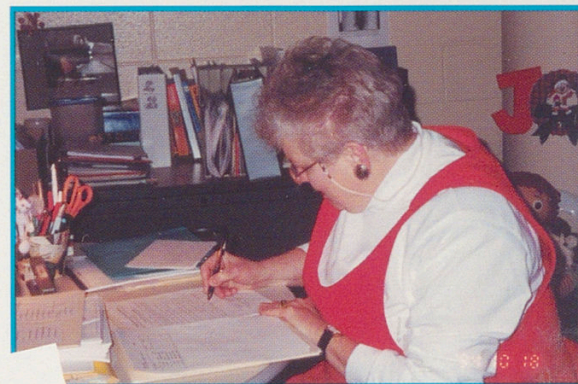
Helping students. Mrs. Diane Jennings, English teacher, assists a student in her second bell English class. She has been a great addition to the English Department for eight years.



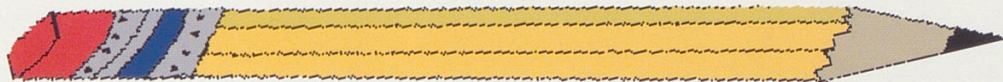
Class hug. Mr. Donald Hayden, Global Language teacher, retired after 30 years. He wanted to include his third bell class in the picture.
