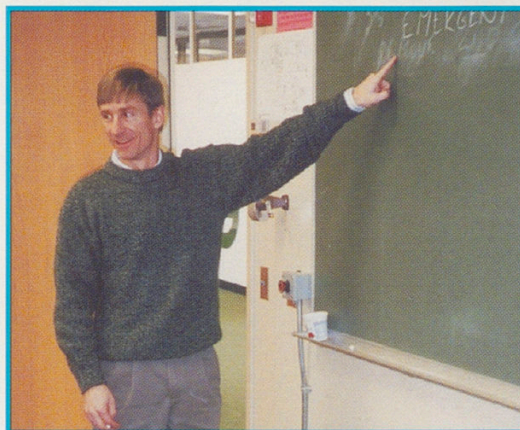

Teachers in the News

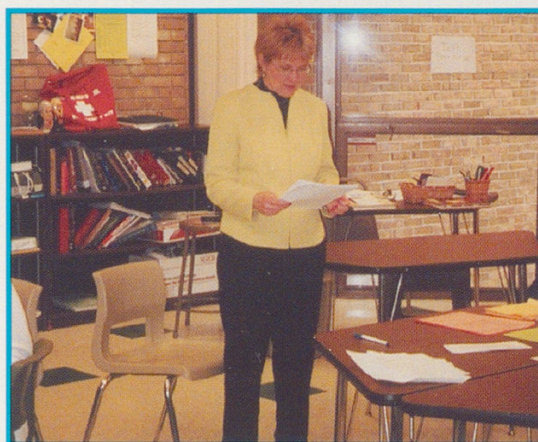

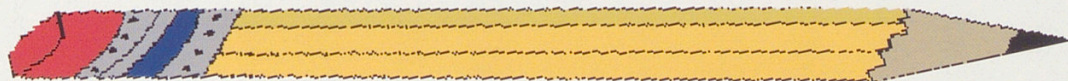
