## BLOOD DRIVE: A way to help

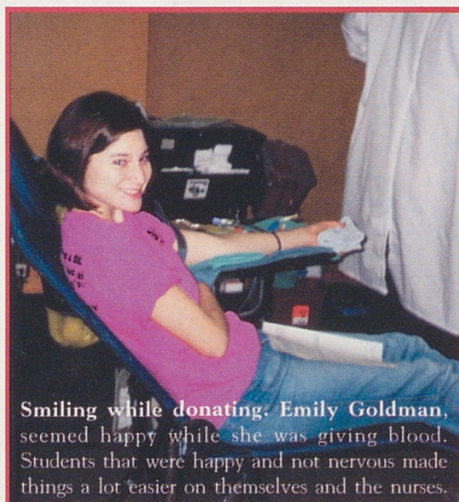
### Stop Watch: donation time

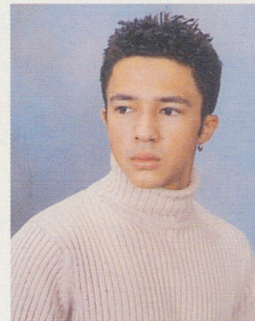
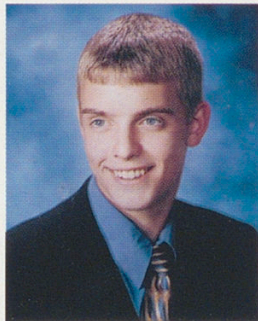
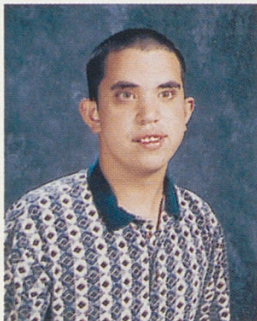


Smiling while donating. Emily Goldman, seemed happy while she was giving blood. Students that were happy and not nervous made things a lot easier on themselves and the nurses.
