

Ball and Chain



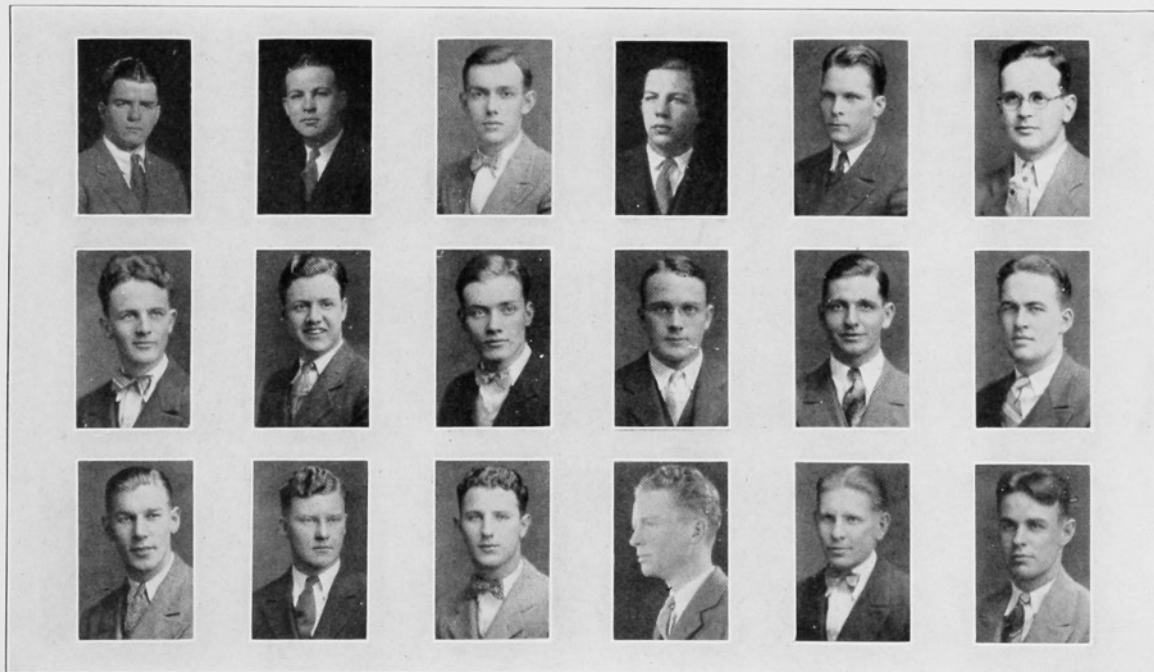
