CINCINNATI, 20—HANOVER, 6
(NIGHT GAME)

IN the opening game of the season, the Bearcats easily romped over their smaller and weaker opponents, Hanover College. Cincinnati used an attack consisting of straight football alone to roll up twenty points. Soon after the start of the game, the Bearcats marched down the field and Fischer crashed across the line for the first touchdown of the season. The second touchdown was made in the second quarter by Bursiek in a similar manner. The last six points were the result of a 20 yard return of a punt by Mullen behind perfect interference. The Indiana aggregation fought hard in a vain effort to pierce the Red and Black defense, but their inferior attack availed them nothing against the play of the Cincinnati line.
