CINCINNATI, 6—TRANSYLVANIA, 25

**A**FTER their fine showing in the Wittenberg game, the Bearcats again fell into the depths by allowing Transylvania to walk over them for a 25-7 victory. The Bearcats however could derive some satisfaction from the fact that they crossed their opponents goal line for the first time since the opening game of the season.

Varsity had a fine chance to score in the first quarter but an incompleting pass over the goal line threw away this opportunity. Then Transylvania gradually forced the Bearcats down the field until Schott was forced to punt on the five yard line. Transylvania blocked this punt and fell on it over the goal line for a touchdown. A blocked punt, coupled with a long pass, accounted for the Kentuckians' second tally.

Transylvania scored twice in the second half as a result of passes. Varsity had several fine opportunities in this half but they threw them all away except that a 15 yard run by Climer on a spinner play accounted for Cincinnati's lone tally.

Again the defensive work of Bursiek and Fischer stood out. The full-back as usual made his quota of about one-half of Varsity's tackles, and he received ample assistance from the half-back.
