## Baseball

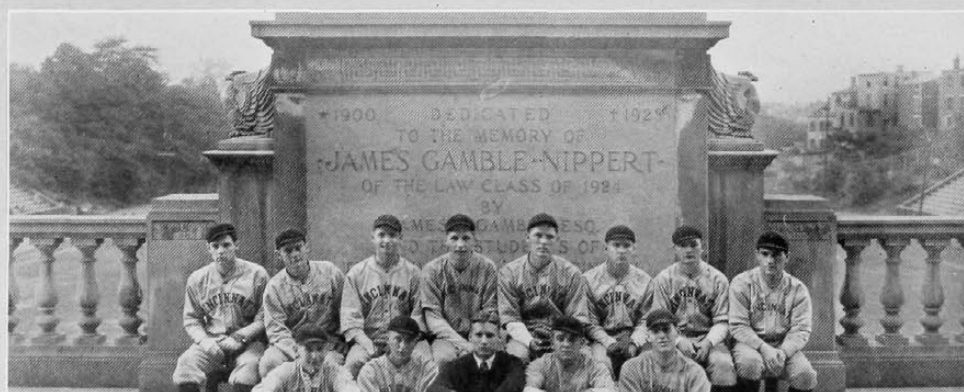
