Due to the fact handball is a game for experts rather than beginners, the number of entries in this sport was rather small. Remarkable ability was shown by the teams that did enter, although most of them were handicapped by a lack of experience. For the third consecutive sport the Sig Chis triumphed, again defeating the Iota Chis in the finals. The victorious team was composed of Carlberg and Potter and the losing team of Ebeling and Toy.
