THE greatest success attained by a Cincinnati forensic team in recent years marked the work of the squad which shouldered Cincinnati's intercollegiate debate relations during the past year. With a schedule of an extent never before approached in the history of debating at the University, Cincinnati's logicians carried the colors of the Red and Black to victory in the great majority of their contests under the able guidance of Coaches Leon C. McCarty and Miss Nesha Isaacs.

The men, in particular, did surpassingly fine work in the course of the past year and turned in a record decidedly in contrast to the disappointing results of the year before.

The influence of the University debate work was also extended during the year to non-collegiate circles by numerous intra-squad contests held before local clubs and organizations.

The men engaged in twenty intercollegiate debates in addition to their intra-squad affairs and the women spoke against six other colleges while also having a large number of intra-squad contests. Among the other colleges met were Denison, Depauw, Albion, Western State Teachers' College, Detroit College, Miami, Ohio University, Vanderbilt, Pittsburgh, and St. Xavier. Most of the debates were duals.
