Fellow Students:

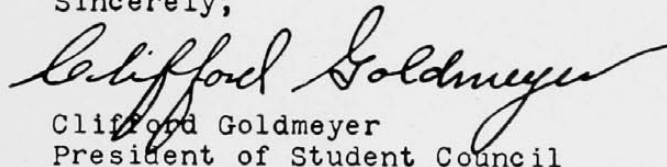
