Regular High School Course Taken in the Academy

OBJECT

The object of the Class of Aspirants is to offer an opportunity for a High School Education to such girls as have completed the Eighth Grade and are inclined to a religious vocation in the Community of the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, Indiana.

CONTRACT

A written contract must be signed by the parents or guardians upon entrance.

Board, tuition and education are free of charge for the student who becomes a member of the Community.

If a student does not remain, One Hundred Dollars (\$100) must be paid for each year spent in the School.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRANCE

Letters of recommendation as to the character and ability from the Rev. Pastor, the Principal of the School last attended, and a health certificate from the family Physician.
